Summary of definition / Condition of use:

See traditional term “Passito”.

It exactly means “wine from straw”.

It refers to the specific wine produced in the province of Bolzano and corresponds to a production method which implies grapes dried, after harvesting, over straw trellis according to the drying method established by the various product specifications.
